

Defendant Alfried Felix Alwyn Krupp von Bohlen und Halbach, eldest son of Gustav Krupp von Bohlen und Halbach, and Berta Krupp, was born in 1907.

During his study years he received training in Fried.Krupp workshops for several months in 1925 and 1926, from Nov. 1935 until Sept.1936 he worked at the head administration of the Fried.Krupp AG for orientation purposes. On 1 October 1936 he entered the firm Krupp, as deputy director (Prokurist), and worked as assistant to the head of the departments War Material and Artillery Development. On 1 October 1938 he became a member of the Vorstand of the Fried.Krupp AG, and head of the departments War Material and Artillery Development; and on 1 November 1938 head of the department for mining, Raw Materials and Transport. On 31 March 1943 he became chairman of the Vorstand and Fuehrer des Betriebes (leader of the enterprise) of the Fried.Krupp A.G. By virtue of the Lex Krupp, the firm of Krupp was made into a "family enterprise", and as of and since 15 Dec.1943, he was the sole owner of this family enterprise and Fuehrer der Betriebe (leader of the enterprises) of the firm Fried. Krupp. At that occasion, he also changed his name from "von Bohlen und Halbach" (his father's name prior to the latter's marriage with Bertha Krupp) to "Krupp von Bohlen und Halbach."

He was a member (in two cases, the chairman) of the Aufsichtsrat

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or of similar high bodies of at least 18 firms connected with the Krupp concern, and of at least 6 firms outside the Krupp concern.

In addition, he held the following positions:

Member of the advisory council, Export Association for War Equipment (Ausfuhrgemeinschaft fuer Kriegsgeraet)

Member of the advisory council and deputy chairman, District Group North-West Iron Producing Industry

Deputy chairman and chairman of the committee "Raw Materials and Transport." Reich Association Iron

Member and Ruestungsrat (Armament Commission) in the Office of the Reich Minister for Armament and War Production

Member of the Praesidium and chairman of the organization committee, of the Reich Association Coal (RVK)

Member of the Aufsichtsrat, Rheinisch-Westfaelisches Kohlesyndikat, Essen

Deputy chairman, Economic group Iron Producing Industry

The defendant Krupp was, furthermore, a member of the Administrative Council of the BHO --one of the organizations set up for the economic exploitation of the occupied Russian territories.

He also was a deputy chairman of the Board of Trustees of the "Adolf Hitler Fund of the German Economy"-- a fund created by, and consisting of large regular donations of, leading industrialists, which sums were put at the disposal of Hitler.

The defendant was a member of the NSDAP since the end of 1938.

From 1931 to 1939 he was a paying member of the SS. He belonged to three other Nazi organizations; in one of them, the National Socialist Flying Corps ("NSFK") he reached the rank of Colonel (Standartenfuehrer) by 1944.

Defendant Krupp was bestowed the title of War Economy Leader as

early as 11 August 1937. He received the War Merit Cross, 1st and

2nd Class.
